

Management Core I: Accounting (10.0 Credit Hours)

Management Core I courses are preliminary **requirements** not prerequisites for admission to the MSM Accounting Program. (See *Pre-Accounting Flowchart for prerequisites*.) However, it is recommended that these courses be completed before the Accounting Jr. Core. These courses **must** be taken before taking the Management Integrated Core or before entering the Master of Accountancy (MAcc) program.

After the Accounting Jr. Core: (1) **BS Accounting** students should complete the Management Integrated Core and Additional Requirements; (2) **MAcc** students will **not** take the Management Integrated Core but instead will take a graduate equivalent core.

Management Integrated Core: Accounting (15.0) **FW**

All Pre-Accounting Prerequisites and Management Core I courses must be completed before taking this Integrated Core. These Integrated Core courses must be taken during the same semester. The Integrated Core is not offered Spring/Summer for Accounting students. No transfer classes may be substituted for any of these Integrated Core Classes.

*Students admitted to the MAcc do **not** take this Integrated Core but will take the MSM Graduate Business Core in its place.*
