You must seek prior approval for any out of program (non MBA) or 300 or 400 level courses you want counted towards your MBA. There is a 9 credit hour limit of those that count towards your MBA. On-line & independent study courses can not count towards your MBA. 18.0 credit hours is the registration limit per semester - this includes everything on your registration.
