However, only a maximum of 3 credits can be taken in MBA 693R, section 1 - readings and conference with a faculty member.</li> <li>You must seek <b>prior approval</b> for any out of program (non MBA) or 300 or 400 level courses you want counted towards your MBA. There is a 9 credit hour limit of those that count towards your MBA. <b>On-line &amp; independent study courses can not count towards your MBA.</b></li> <li>18.0 credit hours is the registration limit per semester - this includes everything on your registration.</li> </ul>
