Electives from other disciplines may also be approved (Information Technology, Computer Science, etc.) on a case-by-case basis by consultation with the MISM advisor (mism@byu.edu, 801-422-5602, 789 TNRB) and/or the Director of the MISM program.
- The GMAT is required for application and must be taken by March 1. Information is available in 789 TNRB.
- Internships are **strongly** encouraged, though not a program requirement.
- **Please note** that with any of these schedules, you **MUST** pay **full** graduate tuition and attend **full-time** your **final two semesters** (if attending **Spring/Summer**, you must be enrolled **full-time** during **both terms**) to be eligible to graduate. Also note that you must pay graduate tuition for all terms or semesters following the date that you begin graduate status.
